

Simple Present



Key Words

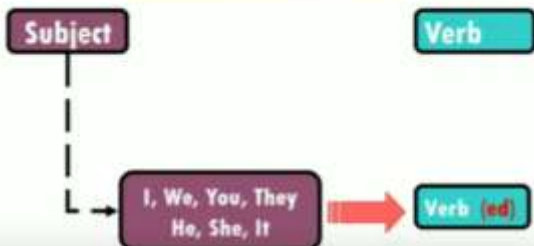
- often
- sometimes
- usually
- always
- never
- every ...
- once/twice.. a day/week...



Examples

- **That old man** **always** **prays** in the mosque.
- **We** **usually** **spend** the summer in Ifrane.
- **My uncle** **visits** us **twice** a week.
- **Water** **boils** at 100 C.

Simple Past



Key Words

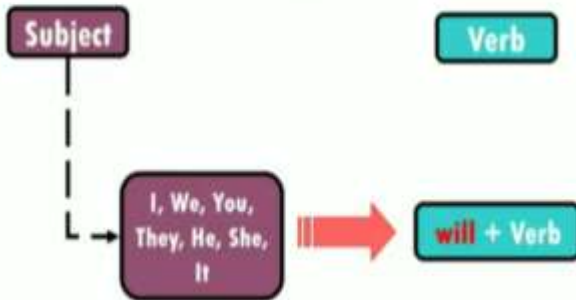
- yesterday
- ago
- last ...
- date in the past. (1990)
- in the past
- once upon a time



Examples

- I **met** Ali two days **ago** in Fes.
- They **got** back very late **last** night.
- I **had** this job in **1999**.
- Adam **learned** English when he **was** in England.

Simple Future



Key Words

- tomorrow
- next ...
- date in the future. (2007)
- conditional type(1)
- soon, shortly, in a few minutes...



Examples

- Ali **will buy** a new car **next** month.
- My family **will spend this summer** in Rabat.
- Our **next** exam **will be** on Monday.

Present perfect



Key Words

- just, already, never, recently ..
- not ... yet
- future ... as soon as, when (after)
- times of doing something.



Examples

- Ali **has just finished** his homework.
- **As soon as** they **have noted** they will go out.
- **Have you ever eaten** Couscous?
- Sara **has not written** the answers **yet**.

Present Continuous

Subject	Verb
I	am + V _{ing}
We, You, They	are + V _{ing}
He, She, It	is + V _{ing}



Key Words

- now, at present
- Look!, Listen!
- at the moment, nowadays
- at the time of speaking
- future indication



Examples

- Ahmad **is sleep**ing right now.
- We **are hav**ing dinner at the moment.
- **Look!** Samir **is read**ing a story.
- They'**re leav**ing for Casablanca tomorrow.



Key Words

- while, when



Past Continuous

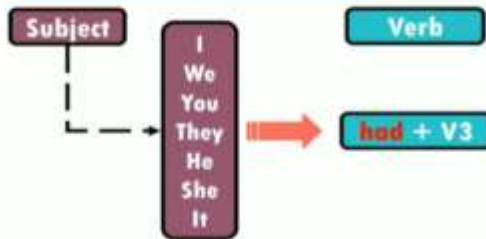
Subject	Verb
I	was + V _{ing}
We, You, They	were + V _{ing}
He, She, It	was + V _{ing}



Examples

- Ahmad **was sleep**ing **when** the bell **rang**.
- We **were hav**ing dinner **when** the lights **went out**.
- **While** Ali **was play**ing he **sprained** his ankle.

Past Perfect



Key Words

- after, when (after)
- conditional Type (III)
- reported speech
- I wish... (past)



Examples

- ~~She~~ I **had come** home, it **started** raining.
- If she **had attended**, I would have seen her.
- I **wish** I **had met** Rashid yesterday. (*I couldn't meet him*)

Present Perfect Continuous



Examples



Key Words

- since, for
- all (day/night/year..)

- I **have been running** **for** two hours.
- Hassan **has been working** here **since** 2010.
- We **have been waiting** here **all day**.
