

The Research Process



^{*}Literature review refers to reviewing the existing works (theories, practices, researches...etc) done in the field for the aim of acquainting the researchers with the existing body of knowledge, establishing background for their work, developing appropriate research methodology and integrating their findings within their field of study. Therefore, this step accompanies other steps in the research process as suggested by the graph.
