



(1)- The boy's learning style is spatial-visual. It is easier for him to learn the skill when watching someone else demonstrating it for him.




(2) The boy's learning style is physical-kinaesthetic. It is easier for him to learn the skill when he practices it.

The girl's learning style is interpersonal. She learns best when she discusses things with others.




The boy's learning style is intrapersonal. He learns better when he works alone.


