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What is Macroeconomics?



Macroeconomics focuses on the performance of economies changes in economic output, inflation, interest and foreign exchange rates, and the balance of payments, Poverty reduction, social equity, and sustainable growth are only possible with sound monetary and fiscal policies.

What is Macroeconomics?



Macroeconomics a branch of economic theory (economics *). It studies the economic behavior of aggregate economic actors (sectors of the economy) in aggregated markets and considers economic issues that affect the entire economy (not individual industries) and society as a whole.

* Economics is a discipline that studies how to allocate and use scarce economic resources in order to maximize production and satisfy increasing needs of people to the fullest.

Macro versus Micro

Micro

focuses on the behavior of small units of the economy.

it tends to limit itself to specific and specialized areas of study.

Macro

has a much broader reach than micro.

It studies the economy as a whole, aggregate measures

Macro versus Micro

Micro

It sudies: the balance of supply and demand in individual markets, the behavior of individual consumers....etc

Macro

It sudies: the implications of fiscal policy, locating the reasons for inflation or unemployment, the implications of government borrowing and economic growth on a nationwide scale...etc

Macro versus Micro

Micro

Equilibrium expresses the optimal situation from the point of view of the economic unit.


is based on partial equilibrium analysis

Macro

Equilibrium may not be optimal for society.

is based on general equilibrium analysis.
