

Unit 7: Intellectual Property Law in Algeria

Intellectual property law in Algeria protects the rights of creators and inventors over their inventions, designs, and artistic works. The Intellectual Property Code primarily governs the legal framework, which aligns with international treaties and agreements.

- **Copyright:** Copyright law protects original works of authorship, including literature, music, and art. It grants creators exclusive rights to reproduce, distribute, and display their works.

- **Patents:** Patents protect inventions by granting inventors exclusive rights to exploit their inventions for a limited period, typically 20 years. The invention must be novel, non-obvious, and helpful to obtain a patent.

- **Trademarks:** Trademark law protects brands and symbols that distinguish goods and services. Registering a trademark protects against unauthorized use and helps maintain a brand reputation.

- **Industrial Designs:** Industrial design rights protect the aesthetic aspects of products, such as shape, pattern, or color. These rights prevent unauthorized copying of a product's design.

- **International Treaties:** Algeria is a member of several international agreements, including the **Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property** and the **Berne Convention for the Protection of Literary and Artistic Works**. These promote cooperation among member states in protecting intellectual property rights.
